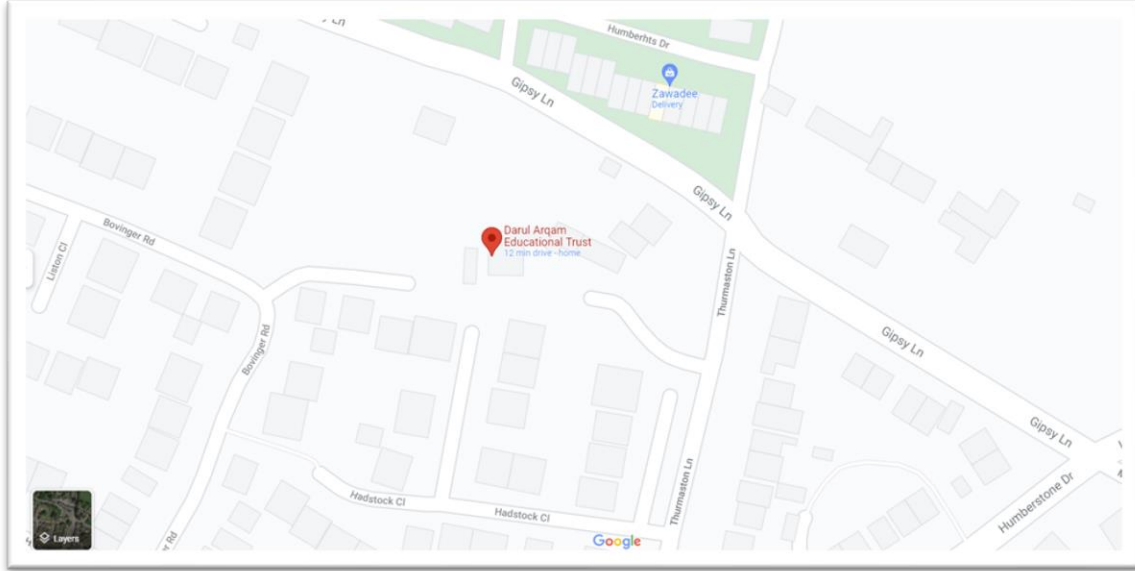

## Car Parking

Please note that the internal car park has limited spaces. You are planning to stay from Friday to Sunday, please park your car considerately in the nearby streets.

## Accommodation

There will be shared accommodation for all students. Bedding will not be provided so please bring a sleeping bag or appropriate bedding including pillows, blankets etc. Due to the limited washing facilities we do advise students to plan accordingly before the commencement of lessons and prayers. There are segregated wash facilities. Each group of students and families will be assigned a 'Mushrif' (responsible person) who will be responsible for reminding students of lessons, Dhikrs and Prayers. We request that students appreciate and respect the 'Mushrif' (responsible person) who will be appointed to maintain sleeping times and other routines during the day.

The brothers will sleep at a nearby accommodation graciously bestowed to us by Darul Uloom al-Imam Malik, 9 Robinson road, Leicester, LE5 4NS. Families with young children and sisters will remain in the Darul Arqam premises.

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## **Meals**

The evening meal on Friday evening (3<sup>rd</sup> December 2021) will be provided and the final meal will be lunch on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> 2021. Tea and Coffee facilities will be available throughout the day in the kitchen.

## **Classes and Prayer**

Classes and prayers will take place in the Masjid. The Dhikr will take place in the main Masjid hall. The sisters will be in the back of the Masjid hall during Dhikr separated by a divider. When there are men members of the congregational prayers present from the local community sisters will perform their Dhikr in the Sisters Prayer room on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor. Sisters will be able to follow the Dhikr and class in the Masjid if we have sole use of the Masjid without the local Prayer Congregation.

## **Children**

The Prophet, peace be upon him, said: 'He who does not show mercy to children is not from amongst us'. Children are very welcome to the Ittiqaf and Divine Mercy accompanies their presence. We would advise for children 10+ to participate in the activities. With great regret however, we are not in a position to offer creche facilities for children under the age of five. We do expect however that the mothers in Muslim fraternity will assist and help each other. All parents must supervise their own children.

## **Clothing**

Please bring a bag to store your clothing, shoes and keep them with your personal belongings. All shoes of all attendees must be placed in the shoe racks in the back of the Masjid not in the front which is reserved for the local community.
